

Map and Directions to Restoration Workday at Coal Oil Point Reserve



We will meet at 9am at the inside dirt parking lot where the Slough Rd dead ends by Coal Oil Point (Aka Sands Beach).

TRAVELING BY CAR:

- If you are coming from Highway 101 take the Glen Annie/ Storke Rd Exit. Travel south on Storke Rd (towards the ocean) until the intersection with El Colegio. Go straight at the intersection of Storke and El Colegio onto Slough Rd (follow the sign towards University West Campus).
- If coming from Isla Vista/UCSB make a left at the intersection of El Colegio and Storke Rd (follow the sign towards University West Campus).

Continue on the Slough Rd for 0.8 miles as it winds around Devereux slough. Important: there are many turnoffs along Slough Rd. Make sure to stay on the road that hugs the slough (the big body of body of water). The road will dead-end at a dirt parking lot with a metal gate at the end. This is the outside parking lot: DO NOT park here, you will get a parking ticket! There will someone at the gate to guide you to inside parking lot.

***Please note that parking is limited so it is strongly encouraged to ride your bike or carpool**

TRAVELING BY BIKE/FOOT:

The bike path begins in Isla Vista at the end of Del Playa and travels east along the ocean bluffs for about 5 minutes. At the end of the bike path there will be several buildings. Make an immediate right down a dirt road that is in front of the first building. Travel down this small dirt road for ~150 feet until you see a parking lot on the left, where all the happy volunteers will be!
