Program Summary: Pollutants such as wash water, bacteria, oil, cleaning products, and hazardous materials can escape from commercial businesses into the City’s storm drain system, which flows untreated to the creeks and ocean. The City Creeks Division is offering a new program to assist business owners in purchasing specific products that will protect water quality by helping to contain and properly manage pollutants before they enter the storm drain system and ultimately the creeks and ocean. For approved products, see the attached list.

Application Process: **(1)** Fill out the applicant information below, **(2)** Submit the application form to the Creeks Division for review (2-3 weeks), **(3)** The Creeks Division purchases the product if/when it is approved, **(4)** Creeks Division staff will deliver the product to your business and assist with set up/assembly, if needed.
