#### CONSENT CALENDAR

1. Minutes from Oct. 13<sup>th</sup>, and Feb. 23<sup>rd</sup> were unanimously approved

#### ADMINISTRATIVE AND STAFF REPORT

2. Committee discussed potential new projects:
  - a. Bunkers – drainage solutions to improve quality of the bunkers
  - b. Shoe Cleaners
  - c. Ball and Club washers on all par 3,s and refurbish existing ones.
  - d. Improve Stone walkways at entrance of #1 and #9 tee
  - e. Addressing issues created by squirrels and other wildlife.
  - f. New Signage on all par 3's "repair ball marks" etc.
  - g. Signage to improve pace of play: eg. Golfers going to 16<sup>th</sup> green may use bridge across habitat if the signs made it clearer.
  - h. New sprinkler and irrigation to right of #3 fairway bunker to increase grass growth.

The previously proposed project to add digital screens to the golf course for informational purposes was again discussed. This project is with the City Attorney for review.

3. The committee discussed 2015, and has determined to act in the best interests of the average player, and to encourage pace of play and inclusivity by adding

forward tees, renovating bunkers and improving the main tee boxes.

4. Simon Herrera, provided a verbal report on the recently completed tee and bunker renovation project.
