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#### **COUNCIL ACTIONS**

Adopted a Resolution establishing a Slip Occupancy Policy for designated commercial fishing slips in Santa Barbara Harbor.

Adopted a Resolution establishing Waterfront slip, mooring and user fees for Fiscal Year 2015.

Authorized the Waterfront Director to submit an application to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for the Fiscal Year 2015 Used Oil Payment Program Grant (OPP Grant), formerly known as the Used Oil Block Grant, in the amount of \$25,600.

#### **ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS MEETINGS**

On May 14, 2014, Facilities Manager Karl Treiberg and I met with Colonel Kimberly Colloton, Commander of the US Army Corps of Engineers Los Angeles Division and some members of her staff. On June 13, Karl and I met with Brigadier General David Turner, Commander of the US Army Corps of Engineers South Pacific Division, to give him an introduction and orientation to Santa Barbara Harbor. We discussed the problems associated with missing the fall dredging cycle and possible ways of improving the Corps' contracting procedures to avoid this situation in the future.

Colonel Colloton and General Turner were very apologetic about the dredging delays that resulted in the harbor closure and committed to working with the Waterfront Department to prevent future delays.
