**SUBJECT:** Bicycle Corral Demonstration Project – End Pilot Program and Approve Two New Corrals

---

The City's first bike corral was approved in the summer of 2014 and installed on September 23, 2014 for an eighteen-month pilot program. At their October 8, 2015 meeting, the Transportation and Circulation Committee and Downtown Parking Committee recommended that the HLC end the pilot program so that other corrals can be installed in the City where sufficient demand exists for bicycle parking.

There are a few more locations, based on available right away, minimal impacts to existing parking, and sufficient bike parking demand that may be candidates for future corrals. Staff is applying for regional Measure A funds to pay for future corrals and needs assurance that the City is willing to continuing using this tool to promote security, sustainable trips, a walkable downtown and to relieve demand on strained automobile parking supplies.

The proposed corrals on the 00 blocks of East Ortega and East De La Guerra are both locations where red curb can be converted to corral space without any loss to auto parking and in areas where existing bike parking is both lacking and in demand.
