ORDER OF BUSINESS: This regular meeting of the Park and Recreation Commission begins at 4:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, 735 Anacapa Street.

Any person wishing to address the Park and Recreation Commission should first complete and deliver to the Parks and Recreation Director/Recorder a "Request to Speak" form prior to the time that the item on the agenda is read by the Park and Recreation Commission Chair. The Park and Recreation Commission, upon majority vote, may decline to hear a speaker on the grounds that the subject matter is beyond their jurisdiction.

PUBLIC COMMENT: At the beginning of the 4:00 p.m. session of each regular Park and Recreation Commission meeting, and at the beginning of each special Park and Recreation Commission meeting, any member of the public may address the Park and Recreation Commission on any item not on the agenda. The total amount of time for public comments will be 15 minutes, and no individual speaker may speak for more than 1 minute.

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT: In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, if you need special assistance to gain access to, comment at, or participate in this meeting, please contact Karla Megill at 564-5430 or inquire at the City Clerk's Office on the day of the meeting.
