Materials related to an item on this agenda submitted to the Park and Recreation Commission after distribution of the agenda packet are available for public inspection in the Park and Recreation Commission located at 620 Laguna Street, during normal business hours."

REQUEST TO SPEAK: A member of the public may address the joint body regarding any scheduled agenda item. Any person wishing to address the joint body should first complete and deliver to the Parks and Recreation Director/Recorder a "Request to Speak" form prior to the time that the item on the agenda is read by the Park and Recreation Commission Chair. The Park and Recreation Commission, upon majority vote, may decline to hear a speaker on the grounds that the subject matter is beyond their jurisdiction.

PUBLIC COMMENT: At the beginning of the 4:00 p.m. session of each *regular* Park and Recreation Commission meeting, and at the beginning of each special Park and Recreation Commission meeting, any member of the public may address the Park and Recreation Commission on any item not on the agenda. The total amount of time for public comments will be 15 minutes, and no individual speaker may speak for more than 1 minute.

AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT: In compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act, if you need special assistance to gain access to, comment at, or participate in this meeting, please contact Karla Megill at 564-5430 or inquire at the City Clerk's Office on the day of the meeting.
