Comments: The Committee recommends that the Commission approve the removal of all (5) trees on the condition the trees are replaced with (1) five-trunk *Strelitzia Nicolai*, Giant Bird of Paradise and (1) three-trunk *Strelitzia Nicolai*, Giant Bird of Paradise – both at least half the height of existing *Strelitzia Nicolai*, Giant Bird of Paradise; (2) *Archontophoenix cunninghamiana*, King Palms with a minimum of 8' of brown trunk height and (1) *Butia capitata*, Pindo Palm with a minimum of 8' of brown trunk height.
