Presentation by Sue Gray, Community Development Business Manager

Sue Gray informed the Task Force of the proposed budget for FY 2015-2016. She stated it was a status quo budget. She further stated all contracting jurisdictions (City of Goleta, City of Carpinteria and Santa Barbara County for Unincorporated Areas) would contribute to the budget by paying their share for program services.

Vice Chair, Dan Herlinger to report on April 7, 2015, Santa Barbara City Council actions on funding recommendations to the Santa Barbara City Council. Request was for \$30,000.
