PUBLIC COMMENT

Charlotte Barnard addressed the public regarding artists setting up in the space to the west of the first crafts section marker.

CONSENT CALENDAR

1. Approval of Minutes of the March 11, 2014 Meeting – For Action

Jason Bryan presented the statistics report.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Consider a new rule regarding soaps.
Continue the discussion from the February meeting to consider the following rule changes: For Discussion
Option 1:
Soaps are allowed in the show only if the craftsperson puts a significant amount of work in the finished product where the work of the craftsperson is more important than the raw materials used.

Option 2:

Soap must be handcrafted in its entirety by the permit holder through the process of "saponification". No commercially made soap or 'melt and pour' soap bases will be allowed in the show regardless of the amount of work the craftsperson places in the finished product.

Option 3:

The existing Arts and Crafts Show Procedures and Guidelines provides adequate instructions for soap products and a new rule is not required.

Jason Bryan reported feedback from management who stated saponification was not required in the past and felt that non-saponifacted products could be allowed in the show.

Margaret Landreau stated that she does not use saponification.

Dow Harris made a comparison of soap to a t-shirt, where t-shirts are not allowed as a raw material.

Marilyn Dannehower referred back to rule B.5 and B.12. suggesting that the work of the artist is an important consideration.

Fred Joehnck addressed the committee stating that the saponification only method supports the overall rules and history of the show.

Ana Maria Gregory addressed the committee stating that she feels soap needs to be made from scratch.

Charlotte Barnard stated that she makes her own jewelry and compared the soap making issue with other artists who buy commercial products to make their jewelry.

John Rindlaub stated that the Parks and Recreation Department ultimately decides show rule changes.

Ms. Dannehower asked to continue the soap item for action at next month's meeting when both crafts section committee members will be present.

2. Advertising update – For Discussion

Jason Bryan stated that there is over \$8,000 in the advertising budget.

The Marketing Coordinator has launched the Arts and Crafts Show Facebook Page.

3. Review the schedule for the major bridge replacement project – For Discussion

Jason Bryan stated that the state funding decision has been made and the project will be moving forward. The project will consist of three stages. The show will lose the four triangular turf areas near Stearn's Wharf for approximately 18 months. The timeline for show impact begins February 2015.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Review the annual budget recommendation memorandum. –For Action

Jason Bryan stated that the city is in the process of making the annual budget recommendation memorandum. There will not be any increase in show members fees for the upcoming fiscal year.

2. Review the draft rule revision guideline. –For Discussion

The committee did not have any recommended changes to the draft rule revision guidelines.
