**CHANGES TO AGENDA**

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Jeff Kennedy would like to propose having a Saturday show following a weather day Sunday.

John Rindlaub stated that in the past having a Saturday show after a weather day Sunday was not approved because show members that showed Saturday's were not allowed to show on Sunday's.

Helen Heising stated that there was a movement to having Saturday shows after weather day Sunday's approximately 10 to 12 years ago and that a 2/3 membership vote was needed, but the vote was not successful.

Mr. Kennedy stated that he would like substantial residency required for individuals joining the arts and crafts show. Mr. Kennedy addressed the advisory committee and suggested having a show member's car wrapped to advertise the arts and crafts show.

Motioned Seconded and Carried unanimously to accept the July 8, 2014 meeting minutes.

Jason Bryan presented the statistics report.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

1. Advertising update – For Discussion

Jason Bryan stated that the arts and crafts show web page is currently under construction. The arts and crafts show web page will consist of a five page webpage including a member directory and the most commonly used forms.

Tony Longo would like the show member directory page to consist of one page for both arts and crafts section instead of one page per section and would like to have a symbol to represent the arts and crafts show.

Mr. Bryan stated that he has been contacting the sign committee. Mr. Bryan stated that Adam Hendel presented a sample sign at the June meeting.

David Lyda stated that cruise ships will be visiting this fall and would like the waterfront department to have arts and crafts show postcards available for visitors.

2. Hand-produced items and reproductions –For Discussion

Mr. Longo presented a written document.

Kevin Loughran made a suggestion to add a date and number of painting and/or photography being sold at the show. Mr. Bryan stated that enforcing members to provide a number and receipt for every piece of artwork sold would be a complicated process. Marilyn Dannehower stated that she does not agree with having the city having to enforce or be accountable for keeping receipts. Mr. Kennedy also disagrees with having receipts and the process would be completely unenforceable. Mr. Kennedy stated that prints are already being made and artists have already moved in to the digital printing format.

3. Bridge replacement project: review placement options for displaced artists –For Discussion

Mr. Bryan stated that that the bridge replacement project schedule has not changed and stated that a method to prioritize affected art section members needs to be implemented before the October space assignment meeting. Mr. Bryan has been communicating with management regarding the possibility of an unpaid leave of absence and how membership dues and space assignment relocations will be prioritized during construction.

Ms. Dannehower asked if artists can move to crafts section.

Mr. Bryan stated that if art section members do move into the crafts section it would be temporarily until construction ends.

Mr. Longo would like show members to get a discount on parking. Mr. Longo stated that artist would like seniority and attendances to be considered when getting assigned to a temporary space during construction.

Mr. Bryan stated that management is considering giving artists a leave of absence during the construction period and stated that there will not be discounts given on parking. Mr. Bryan asked the committee if they want to keep adding art section members to the show and if so would they want the new art section members assigned temporarily to the crafts section.

Ms. Heising asked for clarification on how art section members will be placed and would like to know whether they will they be able to be placed throughout the show or only open spaces or have an area marked as a temporary arts section. Ms. Heising would like to know if crafts section members would have priority on available space assignments over art section members that are relocating.

Mr. Kennedy addressed the committee and does not support closing the art section to new potential members or that art section members should be allowed to move into the crafts section for temporary space assignments during construction.

Mr. Bryan stated that the 16 artist affected by the construction will be going back to their old space with the exception of two spaces that will no longer be available.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

1. Review policy for the minimum number of attendances per year to maintain membership – For Discussion

Mr. Bryan stated that we have not had a waitlist for years to join the show.

Mr. Kennedy stated that when he joined the show in 1985 there was no waitlist, however in the 1990's there was a large waitlist to enter the show.

Ms. Heising stated in the event that there is a waitlist the 12 show minimum attendance per year should be enforced.

Motioned Seconded and Carried unanimously to recommend adding "In the event of a waitlist" to the beginning of rule G.1 so the first sentence will read "In the event of a waitlist, permit holders must show twelve (12) times in a permit year and new permit holders six (6) times in their six (6) month's permit period in order to renew show permit" as an action item for the September meeting.
