Application Number: SGN2014-00103

Applicant: Milpas Community Association

(Concept review of a proposal for a temporary special events sign program which would comprise the installation of a 125 square foot civic event sign during each of three annual events: Trick or Treat, Taste of Milpas, and the Milpas Holiday Parade. The sign would be mounted from private buildings and span Milpas Street two weeks prior to each event, and then removed.)

Committee comments:

1. Board Member Cunningham cannot support banner signs and suggested the applicant pursue an alternative such as a flag program.
2. Board Member Wittausch agreed with Board Member Cunningham and cannot support the proposal. He felt it is outside of the Sign Committee purview and went on to state that Milpas Street has a growing identification, so it would be a good idea to design a series of flags to fit into the community identity. It was suggested that the applicant submit the project for review by the Full Board Architectural Board of Review and, if denied, appeal the denial to the City Council.
