

## PUBLIC HEARING OF THE SINGLE FAMILY DESIGN BOARD

The Single Family Design Board (SFDB) will hold a public hearing to give the public an opportunity to be heard and offer comments early in the review process on architectural design related issues or development plan approval findings regarding the subject property below:

Project Description: Proposal to demolish a 754 square foot, one-story single-family residence and detached 450 square foot storage structure and construct a new 1,143 square foot, one-story single-family residence and attached 494 square foot two-car garage. A 300 square foot raised deck is also proposed. No grading is proposed, and no existing trees will be removed. Access to the site from Sutton Avenue will be relocated to W. De La Guerra Street. Total development on site will total 1,637 square feet, which is .18 or 48% of the maximum floor-to-lot area ratio. This project addresses violations called out in ENF2011-00172.

Public comments will be allowed during review of the project by the SFDB. The SFDB is a body appointed by the City Council to focus on neighborhood compatibility, aesthetics, and design issues. Comments on private views and privacy issues are only partially within the SFDB's authority. Due to time constraints, individual comments may be limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome up to the time of the hearing, and should be addressed to the City Planning Division, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990, or by e-mail to SFDBSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov.

This hearing is for design review only. If the project requires approval by the Planning Commission or the Staff Hearing Officer, you will receive a notice for that public hearing. The scope of this project may be modified under further review.
