RESOLUTION NO. 020-13 2020 ALAMEDA PADRE SERRA MODIFICATION APRIL 17, 2013

APPLICATION OF RICHARD REDMOND, ARCHITECT FOR MICHAEL TOWBES LLC, 2020 ALAMEDA PADRE SERRA, APN 019-163-004, SP-7 RIVIERA CAMPUS SPECIFIC PLAN, GENERAL PLAN DESIGNATION: OFFICE LOW IMPACT RESEARCH & DEVELOPMENT (MST2013-00035).

Proposal for minor rooftop alterations at the southeast corner of Ebbetts Hall, within the Riviera Campus. The proposal includes a 20" increase in height to an existing 22" parapet wall, a 28" increase in height to an existing adjacent 14" parapet wall, and two new rooftop decks. The finish height of these parapet walls, which will surround the two proposed rooftop decks, will be 42". This property is a Designated City Landmark: "Furse Hall, Quadrangle Buildings, Ebbetts Hall, and Grand Stair."

The discretionary application required for this project is a Modification to allow alterations to the existing structure within the required 35' front setback (SBMC § 28.15.060 & SBMC § 28.92.110).

The Environmental Analyst has determined that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

WHEREAS, the Staff Hearing Officer has held the required public hearing on the above application, and the Applicant was present.

WHEREAS, no one appeared to speak in favor or in opposition thereto, and the following exhibits were presented for the record:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Staff Hearing Officer approved the subject application making the findings and determinations that the Modification is consistent with the purposes and intent of the Zoning Ordinance and is necessary to secure an appropriate improvement on the lot. The proposed alterations are appropriate because they will result in minor changes to existing parapet walls to address safety and Building Code concerns, will not constitute an adverse impact to the historic resource, and are not anticipated to have an adverse impact on the adjacent neighbor or Alvarado Place.

This motion was passed and adopted on the 17th day of April, 2013 by the Staff Hearing Officer of the City of Santa Barbara.

- 1. This action of the Staff Hearing Officer can be appealed to the Planning Commission or the City Council within ten (10) days after the date the action was taken by the Staff Hearing Officer.
- 2. If the scope of work exceeds the extent described in the Modification request or that which was represented to the Staff Hearing Officer at the public hearing, it may render the Staff Hearing Officer approval null and void.
- 3. If you have any existing zoning violations on the property, other than those included in the conditions above, they must be corrected within thirty (30) days of this action.
- 4. Subsequent to the outcome of any appeal action your next administrative step should be to apply for Historic Landmarks Commission (HLC) approval and then a building permit.
- 5. PLEASE NOTE: A copy of this resolution shall be reproduced on the first sheet of the drawings submitted with the application for a building permit. The location, size and design of the construction proposed in the application for the building permit shall not deviate from the location, size and design of construction approved in this modification.
- 6. NOTICE OF APPROVAL TIME LIMITS: The Staff Hearing Officer's action approving the Performance Standard Permit or Modifications shall expire two (2) years from the date of the approval, per SBMC §28.87.360, unless:
 - a. A building permit for the construction authorized by the approval is issued within twenty four months of the approval. (An extension may be granted by the Staff Hearing Officer if the construction authorized by the permit is being diligently pursued to completion.) or;
 - b. The approved use has been discontinued, abandoned or unused for a period of six months following the earlier of:
 - i. an Issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy for the use, or;
 - ii. one (1) year from granting the approval.
