DESIGNATION: LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL 3 DU/ACRE (MST2013-00335)**

The 8,124 square foot parcel is located within the Hillside Design District, and is currently developed with a 1,754 square foot, one-story residence with an attached 406 square foot two-car garage. The project site is on the corner of Vales and Margo Streets and the existing structure is non-conforming to the front setbacks along both street frontages. The proposed project involves a remodel to the existing residence. The discretionary application required for this project is a Front Setback Modification to allow window and door alterations within the 30-foot secondary front setback along Margo Street (SBMC § 28.15.060 and SBMC § 28.92.110).

The Environmental Analyst has determined that the project is exempt from further environmental review pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

You are invited to attend this hearing and address your verbal comments to the Staff Hearing Officer. If you, as an aggrieved party or applicant, disagree with the decision of the Staff Hearing Officer regarding the outcome of this application, you may appeal the decision to the Planning Commission. The appeal, accompanied by the appropriate filing fee per application, must be filed at the Planning & Zoning Counter within ten calendar days of the Staff Hearing Officer's decision.

If you challenge the permit approval or environmental document in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Staff Hearing Officer at, or prior to the public hearing.
