**NOTICE OF STREET TREE ADVISORY COMMITTEE VACANCY**

The City of Santa Barbara Parks and Recreation Commission is currently seeking applications for the Street Tree Advisory Committee (STAC). The STAC meets on a monthly basis to review tree removal applications and provide recommendations to the Parks and Recreation Commission. The STAC also makes recommendations regarding street tree designations.

The STAC has five voting members. Terms of appointment are two years. There are three vacancies for terms that begin January 1, 2014. One of the vacancies is for a member that may reside outside the City limits, the other two must reside inside City limits. The Parks and Recreation Department is seeking applicants with knowledge in arboriculture or arboricultural experience in addition to horticulture.

Meetings are typically held the first Thursday of every month at 8:30 am in the Parks Division Office at 402 E. Ortega Street. Meetings include site visits. Total meeting time each month is typically 2-3 hours. Special meetings may also be scheduled. All members are expected to attend all meetings.

City employees are not eligible to serve on the Advisory Committee.
