1) Santa Barbara Bikestation Grand Opening on May 1st at 1219 Anacapa Street

Cyclists can enjoy a free breakfast and tours of the bicycle parking facility at the Granada Garage from 7 am to 9 am. The ribbon cutting ceremony will commence at 9 am.

Bikestation Santa Barbara is an automated bicycle parking facility available to members twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Members choose from a number of affordable payment options. To enter the facility, members simply swipe their automated access key located near the front entrance. The facility has over 70 bike racks, which also accommodate personal bike locks for added security. Members have access to a shower, restroom and personal lockers as well as to a work stand, vending machine and basic tools to perform minor bicycle repairs. 2) **Bike Week 2007** - Bike Week 2007 will be held May 12<sup>th</sup>-May 20<sup>th</sup> 2007. Fifteen special events, including Bike to Work Day on Wednesday, May 16<sup>th</sup> and Bike to School Day on Tuesday, May 15<sup>th</sup> are planned for the week to celebrate and encourage the use of bicycles for transportation. **Bike to Work Day, Wednesday May 16<sup>th</sup>.** The City of Santa Barbara invites all commuters traveling by bicycle on Wednesday May 16th to enjoy two blocks of car-free State Street during its Downtown event from 7:00 am to 9:00 am on State Street at De La Guerra Street. Participants will be treated to free food, drinks, and prizes. Please note that, with prior permission from your supervisor, the City Administrator has approved City employees' attendance at this Bike to Work Day event on **City time** (as long as you bike to work!).

Also available is *Free Parking at the Santa Barbara Bikestation* for bicycle commuters arriving between 7 am and 9 am and picking up their bikes between 4 pm and 6 pm.

3) **June's Team Bike Challenge** helps bike commuters ride on into the summer: Bike to Work Day is a great way to get warmed up for a summer full of bike commuting and SBCAG Traffic Solutions is conducting a month long event to help people ride bikes for transportation. The Team Bike Challenge is a friendly competition that will run for the entire month of June with five member teams making as many trips as possible by bike instead of car.
