



Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge Replacement

Project Update: June 2016

Crews have been removing old bridge deck on the beach-side replacement of the Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge and installing sheet piles to prepare the work area to build the new bridge. Crews will not work on Monday, May 30th in observance of Memorial Day. There will be a special Santa Barbara Arts & Crafts Show on Saturday, May 28th.

Upcoming Work:

Work will continue to dewater construction areas and excavate and remove the old bridge. Near the end of June, crews will begin pile installation to support the new bridge.



Closures:

Throughout Stage 3, the beach-side of Cabrillo Boulevard will remain closed near the bridge. One lane in each direction remains open during daytime construction on the new mountain-side of the bridge.

To accommodate the work area, the left turns from Cabrillo Boulevard to Stearns Wharf (westbound) and on to Helena Avenue (eastbound) are prohibited. Businesses on Helena Avenue remain open with both pedestrian access and vehicle access from westbound Cabrillo Boulevard. Motorists can enter Stearns Wharf from State Street and eastbound Cabrillo Boulevard. Detour signs are in place to highlight access around the closures.

Other Projects:

The Entrada de Santa Barbara project is finishing up street and sidewalk improvements on State Street and Helena Avenue. Helena Avenue should reopen later in June, and State Street will reopen prior to the Fourth of July weekend celebration.

Fall 2014 - Spring 2017:

The Cabrillo Boulevard Bridge Replacement Project includes a new bridge, enhanced Mission Creek banks, and improved pedestrian areas. Cabrillo Boulevard, surrounding businesses, parks, Stearns Wharf, and the Arts and Crafts Show will remain open throughout construction.
