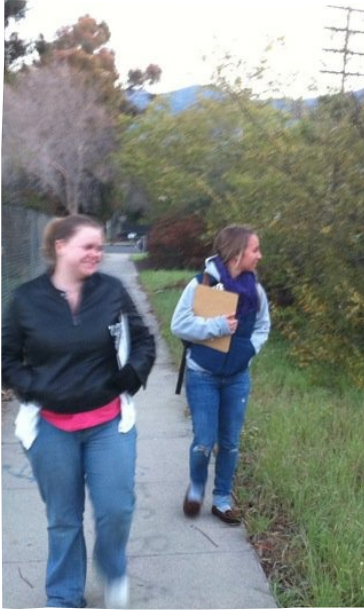


They Count, Will You?
