

Move-Out & Clean Up Trash & Recycling Guide



You don't have to create a mountain of trash to move or clean up. Furniture, mattresses, household items, and clothing can mostly be reused. Electronics, batteries, fluorescent bulbs, aerosol cans, and chemicals are hazardous to the environment and don't belong in the trash. Please do not put any waste out on the street. It is illegal and violators will be cited. See www.SBrecycles.org for details on all wastes types, or call Environmental Services at 564-5631.

NON USABLE FURNITURE, APPLIANCES, TIRES, ELECTRONICS, BULKY ITEMS

Bulky Item Pickup

Each single family home resident that pays a trash bill is entitled to one unlimited quantity free bulky waste pickup per year by appointment only. Residents of apartments, condos, or town homes can pay for a pickup. Place furniture, trash, stoves, washers, dryers, other large appliances, and yard

waste on the curb no more than 24 hours before your appointment, and your trash hauler will pick it up. The waste must be bundled, bagged, or boxed. No hazardous wastes. Call your trash hauler 1 week in advance. *Paid pickups can be by either hauler, so call and compare prices.*

Self Haul of Bulky Wastes

Bring a mixed load for full trash cost, or separate items for lower cost to the South Coast Recycling and Transfer Station or MarBorg.

Go north on Hwy 101, get off at El Sueno, turn left on Calle Real, turn right at sign for transfer station. You must tarp pickup truck loads.

HAZARDOUS WASTES: CHEMICALS, PAINTS, BATTERIES, FLUORESCENT BULBS

Chemicals, fuels, motor oil, oil-based paint, mercury thermometers, space heaters, shoes with lighted soles, barometers, blood pressure devices, fluorescent bulbs, batteries, partly full aerosol cans (empty ones go in recycling): take these items to the Hazardous Waste Collection Center (882-3602) at UCSB. Take Hwy 101 north, get off at Los Carneros, turn left toward UCSB, turn left on Mesa Rd. (just before Isla Vista) and follow signs to the disposal site. Open Sat 9am-3pm, Sun 11am-3pm.
