Recommendation: That members provide feedback to staff about the Annual Workshop for City Advisory Groups held on Monday, April 25, 2011, and ask any related questions.

**6. Subject: Informal Intervention in Title III Issues**

Recommendation: That members receive a review of resources available on the City's web site for private entities covered by Title III of the Americans with Disabilities Act, and of the informal intervention occasionally provided by the City's ADA Coordinator in issues related to access in private places of public accommodation.

**7. Subject: Priorities for Access in the City's Public Rights of Way**

Recommendation: That members: a) receive a presentation from Engineering staff regarding a planned GIS-enabled process to prioritize all of the individual missing access ramp locations throughout the City and to use that list to come up with priority corridors for future City access ramp projects, and b) discuss other Committee priorities and interests regarding access within the public rights of way.

Note: Priorities will be established using objective factors previously suggested by the Committee (e.g., proximity to medical offices/hospitals, schools, grocery stores, public facilities, and transit stops, and whether or not the given ramp would complete the 4th leg of an intersection with 3 existing ramps) and more subjective factors (e.g., a public request for the ramp).
