2. Master Plan

Planning Staff Received 16 public comment letters, mostly from environmental interest groups and regulatory government agencies expressing concerns about the environmental consequences of constructing Taxiway H and the adequacy of the proposed mitigation. Airport Staff intend to meet with environmental regulators to discuss mitigation performance criteria to incorporate into the Final EIR. Once responses to each comment have been crafted, the Final EIR will be presented to Planning Commission for certification.

3. Wildlife Hazard Assessment

The Final Wildlife Hazard Assessment was submitted to FAA in September 2016. The Airport will incorporate any necessary changes once FAA comments are received and will prepare an update to the Wildlife Hazard Management Plan.

C CAPITAL PROJECTS

1. Airfield Electrical, Safety, and Fence Project

Planned Completion Date: June 2016

Construction started on October 19, 2015, and was completed in October 2016. While all original project work was completed October, new work has been added to the project that is expected to commence in January 2017. This work involves the installation of new Medium Intensity Runway Guard Lights on runway 15R and the installation of replacement taxiway edge lights on taxiways Hotel and Juliet. The new scope of work should take approximatley 30 working days to complete.

2. 6100 Hollister Avenue Development

Planned Completion Date: 2018

The Development Plan for this project was approved by the Planning Commission on October 6, 2016, and appealed by the City of Goleta on October 14, 2016. Due to the appeal, the project was removed frrom the October 24, 2016 ABR agenda. The project cannot move foward until the appeal has been resolved. Community Development and City Attorney staff are working to resolve the appeal.

3. Airline Terminal Solar Project

Staff evaluated two proposals that were submitted for construction and operation of a solar photovoltaic generating facility. Endelos Energy was selected. Under a power purchase agreement arrangement the Airport would purchase power generated and supplied directly to the Terminal by the proposed facility. Negotiations with Endelos Engergy to finalize the terms of the power purchase agreement are underway. Endelos Energy will perform further studies of the soil conditions at the site prior to execution of the power purchase agreement.
