This notice has been mailed to you because it has been determined that your property is located within 300 feet of the project listed below. The Architectural Board of Review (ABR) will hold a public hearing to give the public an opportunity to be heard and offer comments early in the review process on architectural design related issues or development plan approval findings regarding the subject property below:

Project Description: **Proposal to construct a new, two-story, 14,032 square foot addition for new permanent classrooms and administration offices at the El Montecito School on a 2.20 acre parcel in the R-3 Zone. The site is currently developed with 17,039 square feet of existing permanent structures and 7,200 square feet of temporary portable units for a total of 24,239 square feet of existing on site development. The proposal includes the removal of the 7,200 square feet of temporary portable classrooms and with the proposed addition of 14,032 square feet of permanent structures. The project will consist of a net addition of 6,832 square feet to the site, and will result in a total of 31,071 square feet of on-site development. The site currently includes 24 parking spaces and the proposal includes the addition of 7 new spaces for a total of 31 parking spaces. The project requires Planning Commission review for Development Plan Approval of Community Priority Designation for new non-residential square footage, a Conditional Use Permit for continued non-residential use in the R-3 Zone, and modifications for parking and lot coverage to exceed 25 percent of the lot for non-residential use.**

Public comments will be allowed during review of the project by the ABR. The Architectural Board of Review is a body appointed by the City Council to focus on neighborhood compatibility, aesthetics, and design issues. Comments on private views and privacy issues are not within the ABR's authority. Due to time constraints, individual comments may be limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome up to the time of the hearing, and should be addressed to the City Planning Division, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990, or by email to ABRSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov.

This hearing is for design review only. The final land use decision will be made at another public hearing. You will receive another notice for that public hearing. The scope of this project may be modified under further review. If you have any questions, wish to review the plans, or wish to be placed on a mailing list for future agendas for this item, please contact the ABR Staff at (805) 564-5470 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and every other Friday.

If you, as an aggrieved party or applicant, disagree with the decision of the Architectural Board of Review regarding the outcome of this application, you may appeal the decision to the City Council. The appeal, accompanied by the appropriate filing fee per application, must be filed in the City Clerks Office within ten calendar days of the Architectural Board of Review decision.
