The Architectural Board of Review (ABR) will hold a public hearing to review architectural design-related issues or development plan approval findings regarding the subject property below:

Project Description: **Proposal for a new residential project using the Average Unit-Size Density**

Incentive Program. The project is located on a parcel currently developed with three structures: "A," "B," and "C." Proposed is the addition of a 446 square foot second story to "Building A," which fronts Castillo Street; a 1,543 square foot second-story addition to "Building B" in the center; and permitting a 401 square foot single-story "as-built" "Building C" at the rear of the parcel. Unit mix will be 1, five-bedroom unit, 2, two-bedroom units, and one, one-bedroom unit ranging from 401 to 1,322 square feet, with an average unit size of 902 square feet. The proposed density on this 8,173 square foot parcel will be 27 dwelling units per acre on a parcel with a General Plan land use designation of Medium-High Density Residential, 15-27 dwelling units per acre. Also proposed are four tandem parking spaces in an 894 square foot addition to the existing garage, and two uncovered spaces. Project will address violations identified in enforcement case ENF2016-01132.

You are invited to attend the hearing and address your comments to the ABR. The ABR is a body appointed by the City Council to focus on neighborhood compatibility, aesthetics, and design issues. Private views and privacy issues are only partially within the ABR's authority. Due to time constraints, individual comments are typically limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome; mail to ABR Secretary, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990 or email to ABRSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov. Please note that the ABR may not have time to consider written comments received after 10 a.m. on the day of the meeting.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This hearing is for design review only. If the project requires approval by the Planning Commission or the Staff Hearing Officer, you will receive a notice for that public hearing. The scope of this project may be modified under further review. To be informed of future hearings, you may:

Decisions of the ABR may be appealed to the City Council. For further information on appeals, contact Planning Division staff or the City Clerk's Office. Appeals must be in writing and must be filed with the City Clerk at City Hall within 10 calendar days of the meeting at which the Board took action or rendered its decision.
