Project Description: **Proposal for a commercial addition. Project is comprised if a voluntary lot merger of two parcels (APNs 017-161-006 017-161-005), the demolition of two single-family residences, and the construction of a 2,992 square foot two-story commercial addition to an existing 3,325 square foot two story industrial building. Also proposed are four new parking spaces. The two existing single family dwellings will be demolished under separate permit. Project requires Staff Hearing Officer review for a Coastal Development Permit and Development Plan Approval findings.**

You are invited to attend the hearing and address your comments to the ABR. The ABR is a body appointed by the City Council to focus on neighborhood compatibility, aesthetics, and design issues. Private views and privacy issues are only partially within the ABR's authority. Due to time constraints, individual comments are typically limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome; mail to ABR Secretary, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990 or email to [ABRSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov](mailto:ABRSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov). Please note that the ABR may not have time to consider written comments received after 10 a.m. on the day of the meeting.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** This hearing is for design review only. If the project requires approval by the Planning Commission or the Staff Hearing Officer, you will receive a notice for that public hearing. The scope of this project may be modified under further review. To be informed of future hearings, you may:
