NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING: Architectural Board of Review (ABR)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Proposal for a three story 6 multi-unit residential building using the Average unit-Size Density (AUD) program. Project entails construction of 6 new 2 bedroom units ranging in size between 835 and 948 square feet, with an average unit size of 894 square feet. The proposed density on the 4,821 square foot lot is 54 dwelling units per acre on a parcel with a General Plan Land Use Designation of Commercial - High Density Residential in the Priority Housing Overlay, which allows between 37 and 63 dwelling units per acre. The proposal includes 6 covered parking spaces and demolition of the existing residential unit and accessory structures.
