- 1. CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL: The meeting was called to order by Phyllis de Picciotto at 3:31 PM and roll was called.
- 2. **PUBLIC COMMENT None**
- 3. ARTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE Phyllis de Picciotto, Chair

### B. Director's Report - Ginny Brush

The Committee heard updates on:

- 1. **Arts Commission's City/County 2012-13 Contract:** On September 11<sup>th</sup>, the Board of Supervisors morning meeting and the City Council's afternoon meeting approved the partnership agreement between the County of Santa Barbara and the City of Santa Barbara to contract with the Arts Commission to provide administer City arts and cultural programs including the annual City arts grants program. City grant recommendations from Events & Festivals committees were approved as presented. This year there was a total of 75 applicants, 67 of which were awarded funds.
- 2. **California Arts Council SLPP Grant Funding:** The California Arts Council is meeting to review and approve grant recommendations for State and Local

Partnership Grants. Arts Commission expects to receive notification of our grant amount by the end of September. SLPP grant funds require a "match" from the City of Santa Barbara and the County.

- 3. **Cultural Arts Enrichment (CAE) Grants:** The Arts Commission has begun its second round of **Community Art Enrichment Grants**, which are County-wide grants with funding support through a partnership of the Santa Barbara Bowl Foundation. The \$25,000 in grant funding will be available September 1<sup>st</sup> online and must be submitted online by September 30<sup>th</sup>. Grants will be reviewed by a committee made up of Arts Commissioners from 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Districts as well as a member of the Santa Barbara Bowl Foundation. Grants will be reviewed on October 16<sup>th</sup> and announced the first week of November.
- 4. **Results of the Americans for the Arts "Arts & Economic Prosperity IV Study":** On October 4th the results will be presented at the Lobero Theatre and a reception will follow on the Patio. Randy Cohen\*, Vice President of Policy for Americans for the Arts will present detailed information and compare National results and trends to our Santa Barbara County study. The Santa Barbara Conference and Visitors Bureau & Film Commission will also be providing information on the economic impact of Cultural Tourism. A Press Release and a Save the Date notice was sent out to all City Grant applicants.
- 5. **Proclamations for October as National Arts & Humanities month:** Staff has arranged for Proclamations to be presented at the Board of Supervisors meeting in Santa Barbara and at Santa Barbara City Council on Tuesday, October 2<sup>nd</sup>. In addition to the usual language about the importance of Arts & Culture and artists in our community, language was included that focuses on the economic contributions of arts organizations and their audiences.
- 6. **The City Arts Alliance Mural Projects:** A number of completed Mural Projects have been very successful, including the most recent "Rise Above" Mural at Bohnett Park. Arts Alliance a program of the City Parks & Recreation Department has been invited to make a presentation at the Arts Advisory meeting in October.
- 7. **Revised Public Art DVD:** Staff is working with Tony Ruggieri of City TV on a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) and script outline. A list of new interviews and upcoming photo ops is also being developed.
- 8. **Chromatic Gate Restoration:** In August the Arts Commission raised over \$79,000 in private funds for restoration of the Herbert Bayer's Chromatic Gate. Now begins the process of coordinating with various City departments to establish a process and timeline for the restoration. The intention is to complete the restoration this fall prior to the beginning of the rainy season.

# C. Update on the Funk Zone – Nathan Vonk

Flyers were circulated announcing the October 6<sup>th</sup> "Focus On the Funk Zone" event, including an invitation to a special tour "art crawl" by Nathan of the "secret places" in the Funk Zone.

- 4. Mary Heebner's group art show is having a gallery tour on October 6<sup>th</sup> at Cabana Home in the Funk Zone
