

RESOLUTION NO. 17-032

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SANTA BARBARA AMENDING RESOLUTION NO.
16-044, ESTABLISHING CERTAIN CITY FEES, TO
AUTHORIZE ADJUSTMENTS TO PARKS AND
RECREATION FEES

WHEREAS, the City provides, maintains and operates a variety of programs and services to the public; and,

WHEREAS, the City Administrator or the Administrator's designee is authorized to make upward or downward adjustments in fees and charges set by this resolution to accommodate fluctuation in program costs and demand and to allow for flexibility in providing programs and services; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed changes to the Fiscal Year 2017 Parks and Recreation Department Schedule of Fees and Charges were ratified by the City Council on February 28, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, the proposed changes to the Fiscal Year 2017 Parks and Recreation Department Schedule of Fees and Charges went in to effect March 1, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That resolution No. 16-044, establishing certain City fees for Fiscal Year 2017, be amended to authorize adjustments to Parks and Recreation fees as follows:
