

RESOLUTION NO. 18-047

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SANTA BARBARA ADOPTING PERMIT AND IMPOUND
FEES

WHEREAS, cities around the state and country have recently seen the introduction and implementation of motorized scooter share programs in their respective jurisdictions;

WHEREAS, the rapid implementation and use of electronic scooters in the City can potentially cause significant safety concerns due to customers illegally riding them on the sidewalks or leaving the scooters on the right of way, impeding pedestrian and vehicle traffic flow;

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code section 21225 allows cities to regulate the parking and regulation of electronic scooters;

WHEREAS, the operation of Shared Mobility Services requires permitting and oversight; and

WHEREAS, the assessment of fees offers a means to recover the costs of such oversight.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA THAT THE CITY ESTABLISHES THE FOLLOWING FEES WHICH SHALL BE EFFECTIVE UPON ADOPTION:

SHARED MOBILITY SERVICES FEES

Municipal Code Chapter 10.53 establishes regulations and permit fees and impound fees for operators of shared mobility service programs.
