1. *Call to Order & Roll Call.* The meeting was called to order at 4:15 p.m. by Chair Donna Lewis. Present: Vice-Chair Alan Kasehagen and Commissioners Kathryn McKee, and Desmond O'Neill. Absent: Commissioner Gabe Dominocielo. City Attorney Ariel Calonne, Deputy City Attorney John Doimas, and staff member Christie Lanning were present.
2. *Public Comment.* Cynthia Goena, from SEIU Local 620, requested that the Hearing Procedures state that the employee's representative will be informed if a witness is not going to appear at a hearing.
3. *Approval of the Minutes from the Meeting of Monday, May 12, 2014.* A motion was made and seconded (O'Neill/Kasehagen) and approved by voice vote.

8. *Adjournment of Meeting.* The meeting adjourned at 5:01 p.m.
