### CONSENT CALENDAR

#### 1. Approval Of Minutes

### ADMINISTRATIVE AND STAFF REPORT

#### 2. Golf Course Performance

Randy Shannon provided a verbal report for the performance in February advising the committee that rounds and revenue were lower than budget in the month, due to the welcome fact that 10 inches of rain fell on the course in the month. Total revenue is now 3% down against actual results for the first eight months in Fiscal Year 2016.

### **3. Golf Programs and Community Engagement Plan**

Randy Shannon presented the plan for camps, programs and special events at the Golf Club, Attached.

### **4. Golf Maintenance Report**

Jesse Seguin provided a verbal report advising the committee that while rain has negatively impacted revenue, it is much needed on the course and given the magnitude of the rains has improved the greens by leeching salt through the root zone. Trees that fell during storm events were removed. The maintenance crew received new ball washers and tee markers and will be installing on the course in the coming weeks.

### **5. Player Improvement Fund Sub-Committee (PIFSC) Report**

John Craig, Chair of the PIFSC advised the committee that there had been no meeting since the last GAC meeting.

### **6. Concession Report**

Mario Medina advised the committee that Mulligans had suffered lower revenue due to rains, but is excited by the quality of the golf course at this time and the impact it will have on the future. Painting will commence in the interior of the restaurant now colors have been approved, and the glass enclosure project will be before Architectural Board of Review soon.

### **7. Home Club Reports**

Men's Club at 240 members, Los Paisanos at 55 and are looking into using MeetUP.com to attract more players to their events.
