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Background

1. Two Types of Annual Waterfront Parking Permits
 - a. \$95/year/General "Red" permit can be sold to anyone in the general public in unlimited quantities, honored in all WF lots except Stearns Wharf. Maximum stay: 72 consecutive hours.
 - b. \$70/year/Slipholder "Blue" permit limited to one person per slip/ business, regardless of how many boat owners share the slip/ business. Honored in all WF lots except Stearns Wharf.
 - i. Exempt from statewide /Citywide 72 hour maximum stay.
2. Vehicle parking priorities
 - a. Public Parking, not storage
 - b. Storage is not an appropriate use of parking resource
 - c. Freeing parking spaces will benefit everyone- slipholders, etc.
3. Two-fold solution
 - a. Policy change- 72 hour exemption
 - b. Increase enforcement on General permits
4. Public Comment /concerns
 - a. Storage vehicles for liveaboards
 - b. Storage vehicles for BAP /Liveaboards / Impact to BAP
 - c. SBCC Parking
 - d. Bicycle storage
5. **Staff Recommendation:** Continue Slipholder discount, but eliminate 72-hour exemption
 - a. Continue to allow 72-hour Slipholder exemption, for a maximum of two weeks every consecutive six months based on ocean travel, and other travel for those with live aboard status, with advance notification.
 - b. Potential three week exemption with prior approval based on extenuating circumstances.
 - c. Take effect January 1, 2014
