COUNCIL ACTIONS

- Adopted an Ordinance amending the Santa Barbara municipal code by extending the time allowed for a slip permittee to replace a vessel that is sold, donated, stolen, destroyed or otherwise permanently removed from a slip from 120 days to 180 days, and eliminating the lottery list assignment fee for slips assigned from the lottery waiting list.
