#### **COUNCIL ACTIONS**

Adopted an Ordinance amending Section 17.12 of the Santa Barbara Municipal Code, establishing a vessel speed limit of five nautical miles per hour in the Stearns Wharf Wye.

#### **MEETING WITH NEW COUNCIL MEMBER OSCAR GUTIERREZ, DISTRICT 3**

I met with Council Member Elect Oscar Gutierrez on July 5<sup>th</sup>. Council Member Gutierrez was officially seated On July 10, 2018. Mr. Gutierrez represents District 3 (Westside) which was vacant after Cathy Murillo was elected Mayor.

We briefly discussed Waterfront organization chart, revenues and expenses and the six year budget and capital plan. Then we did the fun part – a Harbor Patrol boat tour out to East Beach and back, checking sites such as the desalination intake, dredge, Stearns Wharf, and other areas. Council Member Gutierrez is familiar with the Harbor and mentioned that the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks display, which he traditionally watches from a friend's boat in Marina 1, was the best he has seen in years.
