COUNCIL ACTIONS

- Council adopted an Ordinance approving and authorizing the Waterfront Director to execute a ten year lease agreement with two five-year options with Santa Barbara Shellfish Company, a California Corporation, located at 230 Stearns Wharf.
- Council authorized the City Administrator to execute a Representative Services Agreement between the City of Santa Barbara and Carpi & Clay Inc., for liaison and contact services with the United States Government, at a rate no-to-exceed \$1,750 per month, and in a total amount not-to-exceed \$63,000 for fiscal years 2019, 2020, and 2021.
