#### COUNCIL ACTIONS

- The Ordinance Committee forwarded an Ordinance amending Santa Barbara Municipal Code, Title 17, regarding Waterfront Parking Regulations to the City Council with minor changes on September 10, 2019
- Council introduced and approved Ordinance Amendments to Santa Barbara Municipal Code, Title 17, regarding Waterfront Parking Regulations.

#### HARBOR OPERATIONS MANAGER POSITION

Mick Kronman's recent retirement has left the Harbor Operations Manager position vacant. Recruitment for a full time replacement will be postponed until a permanent Waterfront Director is named. The next Waterfront Director would then be part of the Harbor Operations Manager recruitment process and have a say in the composition of the Waterfront's management team. Based on the timing discussed above, the recruitment process for a permanent Harbor Operations Manager would likely take place in the early part of 2020.

Understanding the importance of a Harbor Operations Manager position, we have decided to appoint an Acting Harbor Operations Manager while the Waterfront Director recruitment runs its course. We have offered the position to Harbor Patrol Supervisor, Erik Engebretson, effective immediately. Erik will also maintain his Harbor Patrol Supervisor duties while serving as Acting Harbor Operations Manager. Erik has been with the Waterfront for 30 years and brings a wealth of experience and knowledge to the Department that will serve him well taking on this added responsibility.
