**Subject:** Lottery Drawing For 20-Foot Slip Permits

---

### RECOMMENDATION:

That Harbor Commission, via the Chair, conduct a lottery drawing to rank individuals who applied for two available 20-foot slip permits in Santa Barbara Harbor.

### BACKGROUND:

Waterfront staff has attempted unsuccessfully to assign available 20-foot slip permits through the City's Slip Waiting List Policy. As a result, the Department currently has two 20-foot slip permits to offer. At its March 2021 meeting, the Harbor Commission recommended Staff accept applications in order to issue the unassigned slip permits through a lottery drawing.

### DISCUSSION:

In March 2021, the Department advertised the lottery in the *Santa Barbara News-Press* and *Montecito Journal* (attachment 1), announcing it would accept applications online from 8:00 A.M. April 1, 2021, through 5:00 p.m. April 21, 2021. Additionally, an article was written for the City of Santa Barbara's *News in Brief*. (attachment 2)

To participate in the 20-foot slip permit lottery, an application was made available on the Department's website at [www.santabarbaraca.gov/gov/depts/waterfront/slip\\_lottery.asp](http://www.santabarbaraca.gov/gov/depts/waterfront/slip_lottery.asp) using a proprietary software through a company named SeamlessDocs, who provides secure web-based forms by contract with the City of Santa Barbara. Paper applications were available upon request to those without internet access, but as it happened all applications were submitted online and no paper applications were requested. The application form included information on the submission deadline, eligibility rules, as well as information on the lottery drawing before Harbor Commission (attachment 3). A total of 289 applications were received by qualifying individuals by the deadline (names only in attachment 4).

Staff requests that the Commission Chair randomly draw all 289 names of lottery participants online at <https://www.randomresult.com/pick.php>, to rank the participants for potential assignment of the slip permits. This website was chosen because it uses the most widely used general purposes randomizing algorithm, and also scores 100% high trust rating through [www.scamadvisor.com](http://www.scamadvisor.com).

After the drawing, staff will mail a letter to all individuals to inform them of their rank. Slip permit applications will be mailed to the top two ranked individuals (corresponding to the number of available 20-foot slip permits), each of whom will have 30 days to accept the offer. If any offers are declined or not received by the deadline, staff will mail an offer to the next ranked individual with the same 30-day acceptance requirement, and so on.

Staff will continue this process until both available 20-foot slip permits are assigned and the corresponding slips occupied by vessels. The latter must be accomplished within 90 days of slip permit acceptance. When both available 20-foot slip permits are assigned and vessels have occupied all the assigned slips, staff will discard all names remaining from the lottery drawing. Staff anticipates this overall process will successfully result in assignment of the Department's available 20-foot slip permits.

# SANTA BARBARA HARBOR SLIP PERMIT LOTTERY

Santa Barbara Harbor announces an application period to participate in a lottery for the assignment of 20' slip permits. Lottery Participation Requests accepted from 8 a.m. April 1, 2021 through 5 p.m. April 21, 2021.

## 20-Foot Slip Permit Lottery

The Waterfront Department currently has 20-foot Slip Permits, previously held by sole slip permittees who passed away with no surviving spouse or registered domestic partner. These slip permits have been offered to every individual on the current slip permit waiting lists and remain unassigned.

Details regarding the slip permits are as follows:

- 20-foot slips fit a vessel of a minimum length of 16-feet, up to a maximum length of 22 feet long overall.
- Permitted vessels may be a recreational or commercial, and must meet current operability, seaworthy and stability standards to safely navigate the open waters of the Pacific Ocean.
- Monthly slip fee is \$9.22 per foot of slip or vessel length, whichever is longer.
- Security deposit is \$368.80.
- No slip permit transfer fee.
- Slip Permits issued via Lottery are subject to the 5 year graduated slip permit transfer fee, should the new Slip Permittee transfer the 20-foot Slip Permit to a new party within the first five years of the agreement.
- One lottery participation application per individual or family will be accepted.
- Current slip permittees, and those who are a spouse or registered domestic partner of a slip permittee, must relinquish an existing slip permit in exchange for an assignment of a slip permit in this lottery.

The application period to participate in the lottery for the assignment of a 20-foot slip will be open for a three week period, beginning 8:00 AM PST April 1, 2021, and will close at 5:00 PM PST April 21, 2021.

Lottery participation request forms will be available online [here](#) or by contacting the Waterfront Business Office at (805) 564-5531. There is no cost to participate.

Once the available Slip Permits have been assigned to individuals from this lottery, the lottery process will be considered complete. If any Slip Permits remain unassigned after being offered to every individual participating in the lottery, the Waterfront Department will use the slip space for transient berthing for six months, and will return to Harbor Commission to either request hosting another lottery, or to explore other options.

**APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN A LOTTERY DRAWING FOR ASSIGNMENT OF  
 A TWENTY-FOOT SLIP PERMIT IN SANTA BARBARA HARBOR**

- 20-foot slip permit lottery applications strictly accepted from 8:00 a.m. April 1, 2021 through 5:00 p.m. April 21, 2021.
- The City does not assume responsibility for any lost, late, misdirected, incomplete, or illegible submissions.
- An individual must be at least 18 years of age to participate.
- Only one Lottery Participation Request per individual, family, or legally registered domestic partnership.
- An individual whose name is on a current Slip Waiting List (“Master Slip Waiting List” or “Lottery List”) is not eligible for inclusion in this lottery.
- An existing slip or mooring area permittee (or a spouse or legally registered domestic partner of an existing slip permittee) who is offered a twenty-foot slip permit assignment shall relinquish the existing slip or mooring area permit in exchange for a slip permit assignment from this lottery.
- Lottery drawing will be held at the regular Harbor Commission Meeting scheduled Thursday, May 20, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. PST.
