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#### **FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET APPROVED**

The Santa Barbara City Council formally adopted the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget on June 22, 2021, and the Schedule of Fees on June 29, 2021. Included in the Schedule of Fees were a number of changes to various Waterfront Department fees as follows:

- Slip Rental Fee: 3% increase
- Live Aboard Fee: 3% increase
- Visitor Fee: \$0.50/ft increase
- Boat Impound Fee: \$65 increase to \$100
- Slip Permittee Parking Permit: \$30 increase to \$125
- Terminate Harbor Parking Validation Program

These fees went into effect on July 1, however, the Slip Permittee Annual Parking Permit fee will go into effect when sales open for calendar year 2022 on December 1, 2021.

#### **COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM TRAINING FOR WATERFRONT TENANTS**

As discussed at the June 17, 2021, meeting of the Harbor Commission, the Business Services Division is currently working with the City's Emergency Services Manager to arrange and conduct a free Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training for Waterfront tenants similar to what was offered in the fall of 2018.
