#### **UNITED WAY – WORK FOR GOOD PILOT PROGRAM**

United Way, in partnership with the City of Santa Barbara's Environmental Services Division, is launching the *Work For Good* pilot program starting August 8, 2021. This pilot program is fully funded by United Way and will provide work experience for unsheltered individuals within the Waterfront as well as other City locations.

Supervised individuals will perform various work tasks including: picking up litter, sweeping, general cleanup, graffiti removal, light landscaping, and other similar tasks. The crews will work Monday thru Friday, 8:00am to 12:00pm, within the Waterfront and the pilot program will run for approximately 4 months.

Environmental Services will administer the program, and work with Waterfront staff and United Way. United Way will cover all programmatic expenses including the \$17/hr wage paid to those working in the program.
