

## NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING OF THE HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION

The Historic Landmarks Commission (HLC) will hold a public hearing to give the public an opportunity to be heard and offer comments early in the review process on architectural design related issues or development plan approval findings regarding the subject property below:

This property is on the City's List of Potential Historic Resources: Project Description: "Edwards/Dole House." Proposal for alterations and additions to an existing, three-story, 5,203 square foot, single-family residence, located on a 13,510 square foot parcel. The project includes a request to permit the 139 square foot "as-built" dormer addition, a 142 square foot "as-built" deck constructed on the third floor, and the 362 square foot "as-built" second-story sunroom addition, the replacement of aluminum windows on the "as-built" second-story sunroom with (period-correct) wood windows, and the replacement and installation of new skylights. The proposal also includes additions and alterations to the existing garage including relocating the existing 408 square foot, two-car garage (and 244 square foot loft above the garage) to comply with required front setback, adding 60 square feet to meet the minimum interior dimensions, and window and door changes. The existing driveway material is to be removed and replaced with a 540 square foot brick driveway including a integrated brick inlaved vehicular turntable. This project will address violations identified within enforcement case ENF2013-00546 including "as-built" window and skylight changes to the existing 267 square foot detached accessory building and the demolition of other unpermitted structures. The proposed site development totals 6,683 square feet. The project is 149% of the required floor-to-lot area ratio (FAR). The application requires Planning Commission review for a requested floor area and setback modifications.

Public comments will be allowed for consideration by the HLC as part of the public hearing process. The HLC is the Commission appointed by the Council to review and make recommendations regarding the possible designation historic resources. Due to time constraints, individual comments may be limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome up to the time of the hearing, and should be addressed to the City Planning Division, P.O. This hearing is for design review only. If the project requires approval by the Planning Commission or the Staff Hearing Officer, you will receive a notice for that public hearing. The scope of this project may be modified under further review.
