Notice is hereby given that the Historic Landmarks Commission of the City of Santa Barbara (HLC) is considering removal of the following structures from the Potential Historic Resources List as they no longer meet the criteria to qualify as historic resources due to alterations of character-defining features:

1. **Holman Bungalow Court, 1426 Garden Street**
2. **Bungalow residence, 932 Nopal Street**
3. **Vernacular cottage, 202 Soledad Street (1201 East Yanonali Street)**
4. **Victorian residence, 422 West De La Guerra Street**
5. **Former Jordanos Grocery Store, 104 West Anapamu Street**

The purpose of the public hearing will be to review the condition of the structure and take public comment. The Commission will vote that the structures be removed from the Potential Historic Resources List as they no longer meet the criteria to qualify as historic resources due to alterations of character-defining features.
