Notice is hereby given that the Historic Landmarks Commission of the City of Santa Barbara (HLC) is considering the addition of the following structure to the Potential Historic Resources List as it was found to meet the criteria to qualify as a historic resource in a staff evaluation.

- 1. 29-37 East Victoria, designed by noted architects, Soule, Murphy and Hastings in 1922 as Spanish Colonial Revival commercial building. APN 039-133-009**

The purpose of the public hearing will be to review the significance of the structure and take public comment. The Commission will consider a request from the property owner to add the property to the Potential Historic Resources List as it meets the criteria to qualify as a historic resource. Staff found it is significant for its architectural style and as the work of noted architects whose work is important to the heritage of Santa Barbara.
