The Historic Landmarks Commission (HLC) will hold a public hearing to review architectural design-related issues or development plan approval findings regarding the subject property below:

Project Description: **Proposal for minor exterior alterations including a 58 (gross) square foot addition for a new elevator at the rear of an existing two-story, 2,787 square foot residence with a detached one-car garage. The project includes a new uncovered parking space, mechanical mechanism for the driveway gate, removal of a trash enclosure from the front and interior setbacks, and removal of a trellis from the interior and rear setbacks. The project will address violations in Zoning Information Report ZIR2016-00099. The proposed total of 2,844 square feet on an 8,712 square foot lot in the Hillside Design District is 85% of the maximum allowed floor-to-lot area ratio (FAR). The project requires Staff Hearing Officer review for requested Zoning Modifications to allow the elevator at the back of the dwelling to be located within the required open yard area and a new uncovered tandem parking space to be located in the front yard and the required interior setback. The residence is on the City's List of Potential Historic Resources. Residence designed by Mildred and Harriett Moody, aka "Moody Sisters."**

You are invited to attend the hearing and address your comments to the HLC. The HLC is a Commission appointed by the City Council to review projects located within the El Pueblo Viejo district or involving City historic resources. Due to time constraints, individual comments are typically limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome; mail to HLC Secretary, P.O. Box 1990, Santa Barbara, CA 93102-1990 or e-mail to HLCSecretary@SantaBarbaraCA.gov. Please note that the HLC may not have time to consider written comments received after 10 a.m. on the day of the meeting.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: This hearing is for design review only. If the project requires approval by the Planning Commission or the Staff Hearing Officer, you will receive a notice for that public hearing. The scope of this project may be modified under further review. To be informed of future hearings, you may:

1. Submit a request in writing to become an "Interested Party" for notification by mail or e-mail when the project is scheduled on an agenda. Agendas are posted and mailed/e-mailed to interested parties 72 hours before the meeting.
2. Join the City's SantaBarbaraCA.gov/MySB to subscribe to e-mail notification whenever HLC agendas are posted. This is a general subscription to all HLC agendas.

Office hours are 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday, and every other Friday (see SantaBarbaraCA.gov/Calendar for closure dates).

Decisions of the HLC may be appealed to the City Council. For further information on appeals, contact Planning Division staff or the City Clerk's Office. Appeals must be in writing and must be filed with the City Clerk at City Hall within 10 calendar days of the meeting at which the Commission took action or rendered its decision.
