The Historic Landmarks Commission (HLC) will hold a public hearing to review architectural design-related issues or development plan approval findings regarding the subject property below:

Project Description: **This is a revised project description. The project has increased from 34 to 42**

**residential units and the total proposed floor area from approximately 38,282 to 40,820 square feet. The project site contains a Queen Anne historic building eligible to be designated as a City Landmark: Ott House. Proposal for a new residential project using the Average Unit-Size Density Incentive Program. The project will comprise a voluntary lot merger of three parcels: APNs 037-041-008, 037-041-009, and 037-041-010 (809 and 815 De La Vina Street, and 208 W. De La Guerra Street). The project involves the demolition of all existing improvements, except the Ott House, and constructing one new 3-story apartment building, and one new 4-story apartment building. The unit mix will be 4 studio apartments, 27 one-bedroom apartments, and 11 two-bedroom apartments, with an average unit size of approximately 685 square feet. A ground level parking garage with stackers is proposed under the new 3-story building that will provide approximately 43 parking spaces, and approximately 42 bike spaces. Project is within the Priority Housing Overlay (37-63 DU/ACRE)**

You are invited to attend the hearing and address your comments to the HLC. The HLC is a Commission appointed by the City Council to review projects located within the El Pueblo Viejo district or involving City historic resources. Due to time constraints, individual comments are typically limited to two minutes. Written comments are also welcome. Mail to HLC Secretary, P.O. Please note that the HLC may not have time to consider written comments received after 10 a.m. on the day of the meeting.

The scope of this project may be modified under further review.
