WHEREAS, Section 22.22.050 of the Municipal Code of the City of Santa Barbara grants the Historic Landmarks Commission the authority to initiate a designation process to recommend to the City Council the designation as a City Landmark of any structure, natural feature, site, or area having historic, architectural, archaeological, cultural, or aesthetic significance;

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2017, the Historic Landmarks Commission adopted Resolution of Intention 2017-22 to hold a public hearing to consider a recommendation to City Council for designation of the La Arcada Building located at 1110-1114 State Street as a City Landmark;

WHEREAS, the Staff Report found the property meets four City Landmark criteria listed in section 22.22.040 of the Municipal Code and concluded that the 1926 La Arcada commercial building was designed as a mixed-use residential and restaurant destination on State Street by noted architect Myron Hunt in the Spanish Colonial Revival style and is significant for its historical and architectural influence on the heritage of the City;

WHEREAS, the building has retained a high level of historical integrity as its location, design, materials, setting, feeling, association, and workmanship have not been altered so that it conveys its original 1926 appearance;

WHEREAS, the proposed boundary of the City Landmark designation includes the entire parcel, as the parcel is mostly dedicated to the building and paseo, and to allow for adequate review of any changes for compatibility;

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Article 19, Section 15308 of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines and the City List of Activities Determined to Qualify for a Categorical Exemption (City Council Resolution Dated November 10, 1998), staff has determined that designation of the La Arcada as a City Landmark is eligible for a Categorical Exemption;

WHEREAS, Section 22.22.050 of the Municipal Code of the City of Santa Barbara states that the City Council may designate as a Landmark any structure, natural feature, site, or area having

historic, architectural, archeological, cultural, or aesthetic significance by adopting a resolution of designation within 90 days following receipt of a recommendation from the Historic Landmarks Commission; and

WHEREAS, in summary, the Historic Landmarks Commission finds that the La Arcada Building at 1110-1114 State Street, Assessor's Parcel No. 039-232-009, meets the following City Landmark four criteria listed in section 22.22.040 of the Municipal Code:

- A. Its character, interest or value as a significant part of the heritage of the City, the State or the Nation;
- D. Its exemplification of a particular architectural style or way of life important to the City, the State or the Nation;
- F. Its identification as the creation, design or work of a person or persons whose effort has significantly influenced the heritage of the City, the State or the Nation; and
- G. Its embodiment demonstrating outstanding attention to architectural design, detail, materials or craftsmanship.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that on December 13, 2017, the Historic Landmarks Commission of the City of Santa Barbara hereby recommends to the City Council that it designate La Arcada Building located at 1110-1114 State Street, Assessor's Parcel No. 039-232-009, as a City Landmark and makes findings based on the historic and cultural significance of facts presented in the Staff Report.
