WHEREAS, Section 22.22.085 of the Municipal Code of the City of Santa Barbara grants the Historic Landmarks Commission the authority to designate as a Structure of Merit any structure, natural feature, site or area having historic, architectural, archaeological, cultural or aesthetic significance;

WHEREAS, the legal property owners of 841 Cima Linda Lane, Santa Barbara, California are Zeus Trust;

WHEREAS, the legal description of the property is attached as Exhibit A;

WHEREAS, based on the evidence in the Staff Report, the HLC finds that the house qualifies for historic designation under City of Santa Barbara Master Environmental Assessment criteria;

WHEREAS, the house, constructed in 1926 designed in the Spanish Colonial Revival style by Carlton Monroe Winslow, is significant for its historical and architectural influence on the heritage of the City;

WHEREAS, the Historic Landmarks Commission has acquired authorization from the property owner to designate 841 Cima Linda Lane as a City of Santa Barbara Structure of Merit;

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2018, the Historic Landmarks Commission adopted a Resolution of Intention No. 2018-15 to hold a public hearing to consider the Structure of Merit designation for the Spanish Colonial Revival style at 841 Cima Linda Lane; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Landmarks Commission held a public hearing on November 28, 2018, during which hearing comments were invited on the proposed Structure of Merit designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SANTA BARBARA THAT:

SECTION 1. The property at 841 Cima Linda Lane, Assessor's Parcel No. 015-202-030, is designated as a City of Santa Barbara Structure of Merit.

SECTION 2. The City Structure of Merit designation boundary includes the entire parcel of the Spanish Colonial Revival style house constructed in 1926 at 841 Cima Linda Lane.

SECTION 3. The Historic Landmarks Commission finds that the subject property meets the following Structure of Merit criteria listed in section 22.22.040 of the Municipal Code:

- A. Its character, interest or value as a significant part of the heritage of the City, the State or the Nation;
- D. Its exemplification of the best remaining architectural type in a neighborhood;
- F. Its identification as the creation, design or work of a person or persons whose effort has significantly influenced the heritage of the City, the State or the Nation; and
- G. Its embodiment demonstrating outstanding attention to architectural design, detail, materials or craftsmanship.
