**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Proposal for improvements to Reach 3, part of the Lower Mission Creek Flood Control Project, located between Highway 101 and the Gutierrez Street Bridge. The project includes the removal of concrete sloped embankment, concrete riprap, and non-native vegetation, and the construction of a new vertical concrete wall, natural channel banks with rock slope protection, and installation of native vegetation.
