NOTE TO INTERESTED PARTIES: Only those persons who participate through public comment either orally or in writing on an item on this Agenda have standing to appeal the decision. Grounds for appeal are limited to those issues raised either orally or in written correspondence delivered to the review body at, or prior to, the public hearing.

STATE POLITICAL REFORM ACT SOLE PROPRIETOR ADVISORY: State law, in certain circumstances, allows an architect, engineer, or a person in a related profession who is a "sole practitioner" to make informational presentation of drawings or submissions of an architectural, engineering, or similar nature to the same Commission on which he or she is seated, if the practitioner does not advocate for the project.

LICENSING ADVISORY: The Business and Professions Code of the State of California and the Municipal Code of the City of Santa Barbara restrict preparation of plans for certain project types to licensed professionals. See HLC Guidelines 2.1.2A and 3.1.2C for specific information.

Consent items are reviewed in a sequential manner as listed on the agenda. Applicants are advised to approximate when their item is to be heard and should arrive 15 minutes prior to the item being announced. If applicants are not in attendance when the item is announced, the item will be moved to the end of the agenda.

The applicant's presence is suggested in order to respond to questions and discuss potential conditions of approval, thereby avoiding project continuances. If an applicant cancels or postpones an item without advance notice, the item will be postponed indefinitely and will not be placed on the following Historic Landmarks Commission (HLC) agenda.

Actions on the Consent agenda are reported to the Full Commission at the 1:30 p.m. meeting on the same day. The Full Commission has the discretion to ratify or not ratify the Consent actions. The Consent agenda reviewing member of the HLC may refer items to the Full Commission for review.

CEQA Guidelines §15183 Exemptions (Projects Consistent with General Plan). Under this California

Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines section, projects with new development (new nonresidential square footage or new residential units) qualify for an exemption from further environmental review documents if (1) they are consistent with the General Plan development density evaluated in the 2011 General Plan Program Environmental Impact Report, and (2) any potentially significant project-specific impacts are addressed through existing development standards. Section 15183 exemptions are determined by staff based on a preliminary environmental review process. A decision-maker CEQA finding is required for a Section 15183 exemption. City Council General Plan environmental findings remain applicable for the project.

(The Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History is a designated Structure of Merit. Proposal to repair the existing non-historic wood-framed and steel reinforced bridge in order to address deterioration of the structure. Existing girders will remain in place and be strengthened with steel channels. Existing guardrails will be replaced, like for like. Existing utilities mounted to the outside face of the bridge guardrail will be relocated to below the decking in order to conceal them from view.)

(The Spanish Colonial Revival style residence constructed in 1923 is on the City's List of Potential Historic Resources as it is eligible for designation as a Structure of Merit. Proposal to address violations listed in ENF2020-00159 including replacement of vinyl windows with new divided lite casement windows to match the original removed windows, removing an aluminum window at the Sola Street façade to be replaced with a pair of wood divided lite French doors, re-install four wood divided lite casement windows that were removed and plastered over at the first and second floor south façade and replace two smaller vinyl windows. Project includes a request to not re-install the second floor pergola that was removed without a permit circa 1995 due to severe deterioration.)

Project Design Approval and Final Approval are requested. Historic Resource findings are required.
