NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING: Historic Landmarks Commission (HLC)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The 1930 Spanish Colonial Revival house designed by architect L.E. Cooke is eligible to be designated as a Structure of Merit. Proposal to construct a new 580 square foot 2-Car garage, 173 square feet of first story additions, and an 847 square foot second story addition with two second story balconies. Project includes the enclosure of an existing front entry alcove and the installation of a garden fountain. Project will abate violations in ZIR2019-00322 and ENF2019-00567. The proposed total of 4,992 square feet of development on a 15,660 square foot lot is 114% of the guideline maximum floor-to-lot area ratio (FAR).

To be informed of future hearings, you may (1) Submit a request electronically to become an "Interested Party" for notification by email when the project is scheduled on an agenda.
