**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING:** Historic Landmarks Commission (HLC)

**PROJECT LOCATION:** Mission Canyon Bridge, **ZONE:** RS-15, **APN:** ROW-361, **PLN2021-00253** **APPLICANT/OWNER:** Public Works Department/City of Santa Barbara

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Public Works Department is requesting Historic Landmarks Commission feedback on three conceptual bridge treatment options and three conceptual roadway approach options that have been developed as part of the initial Mission Canyon Bridge Studies effort to address deficiencies in the bridge and surrounding roadway.

Mission Canyon Bridge, a City Landmark, spans Mission Creek and is located to the north of Mission Santa Barbara and Mission Historical Park, south of Rocky Nook Park, and east of the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History. The bridge was designed and constructed by Rowland Hazard in 1891. A wooden sidewalk, supported off the bridge, was added in 1929 and the bridge was widened on the downstream side in 1930. The Mission Canyon Bridge Studies effort kicked off in April 2019 to study existing conditions and challenges associated with the bridge. On December 2, 2020, Public Works presented the three bridge options as well as three roadway alignment options to the public during a public meeting. The options were met with mixed opinions. It is anticipated that an Environmental Impact Report will be required for a full discussion of any proposed project alternatives. Public Works Department is requesting preliminary review comments from the Historic Landmarks Commission before proceeding with a formal project application.
